- (a) The applications in respect of eligible events occurring after 11.08.2022, and those who have not received the cash award for these events, will be submitted only by the sportspersons directly through the DBT-MIS portal of Department of Sports (https://dbtyas-sports.gov.in), within a period of six months from the last date of conclusion of the concerned event;
- (b) Applicants are hereby given a one-time opportunity for applying under cash award scheme, **till 30.04.2023**, in respect of eligible events which occurred prior to 11.08.2022 and for those who have not received the cash award for these events. The application will be submitted only through the DBT-MIS portal of Department of Sports (<u>https://dbtyas-sports.gov.in</u>). No physical applications shall be accepted.
