Dear All,

In continuation to our letter dated 26.05.2025, as was informed that Amateur Kabaddi Federation of India has allotted 1st Under 18 National Kabaddi Championship 2025 (Boys and Girls) to Uttarakhand Kabaddi Association from 28th June 2025 to 1st July 2025 at Shree Prem Nagar Ashram, Near Ranipur Mod, Haridwar.

Eligibility: Age 15-18 years [Above 15 years and below 18 years as on 31/12/2025]

Weight category: Boys-not greater than 70 Kgs & Girls not greater than 65 Kgs.

Entry form should be filled online. A copy of the same duly signed and stamped by the State/UT Association should be carried to the venue of 1st Under 18 National Kabaddi Championship 2025 (Boys and Girls).

BOARDING & LODGING

The Organizing Committee will provide free boarding and lodging to the participating teams and officials including local transportation from the venue for the period 27th June 2025 to 02nd July 2025.

DRESS CODE

All the participating units must prepare colour uniform having chest numbers in 4" size on front side and 6" size on back side. Any team or player found violating the dress code shall be subject to disciplinary action.

Please note that the online process of Player registration must be completed on the AKFI Website by each player of your State / UT Unit. No player will be allowed to play without online registration number / ID Card.

Please ensure that player should carry their Aadhar Card during weighing otherwise certificate will not be issued. AADHAR CARD is must for registration.

Also please send State Flag with your team for March past purpose.

It is requested to all the AKFI Affiliated units to kindly extend their full cooperation by sending the Online Entries on or before 23rd June 2025 to make the Championship a grand success.

The Organizing Committee will issue a circular giving all the details in due course.

No minimum age requirement.- To be eligible to participate in the Youth Olympic Games Dakar 2026, all athletes must: • Have participated in at least one (1) BWF Sanctioned tournament; OR • Appear in the BWF World Junior Ranking prior the Sport Entries Deadline (25 September 2026).
Athletes must be born between 1 January 2009 and 31 December 2010 (inclusive).
Athletes must be born between 14 November 2008 and 31 December 2009 (inclusive).
