Dear All,

This is to inform that Amateur Kabaddi Federation of India (AKFI) has allotted the **51st Junior National Kabaddi Championship– Girls to Bengal Amateur Kabadi Association** and Bengal Amateur Kabadi Association has decided to conduct 51st Junior National Kabaddi Championship – Girls at **Dum Dum Jail Ground, Kolkata** from **25th December 2025 to 28th December 2025**. (Approximately 12kms from Main Railway Station, Howrah Junction).

Venue Information:

Football Ground of Dum Dum Central Correctional Home, Post Office Road, Post Office – Dum Dum, Kolkata – 700028.

Travel Information:

1. Nearest Railway Station: Dum Dum Cantonment Station (approximately 1 km from the venue).
2. Main Railway Station: Howrah Junction (approximately 12 km from the venue).
The Organising Committee will provide the buses from both the railway stations with prior intimation.
3. Nearest Airport: Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose International Airport (Calcutta Airport) (approximately 1.5 km from the venue).

Eligibility & Match Regulations:

- **Weight Eligibility:** Girls–65kg and below.
- **Age Eligibility:** The eligibility of age for Junior Girls- should be below 20 years on the last day of the event.
- **Number of players:** Pursuant to the unanimous decisions made in the AKFI-AGM on 06/04/2025-Number of players shall be 14 per team.
- **Match Surface:** Matches will be played on mats.
- **Playing Gear:** Every player must wear playing shoes; players without appropriate foot wear will not be allowed to play.

Entry & Registration:

The **Entry Form** must be filled online, a printed copy of the entry form should be carried to the venue. **Online Player Registration** is mandatory on the AKFI website. Players without an **Online**



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Registration Number/ID Card will not be permitted to participate, **Change of Chest Number** after submitting the online entry form is not allowed, **Physical proof of Aadhar Card is compulsory** for registration and verification during the weighing process.

Amateur Kabaddi Federation of India has decided that all affiliated States/UTs should **select the players of their respective state/UT only** as by selecting outside players in the team not only deprives the players of the respective state/UT but also at the very same time does not help in developing the Game in all the States/UTs.

Selection of outside players for extraneous considerations is detrimental to the growth of players and no certificate of any type will be issued by AKFI.

Hence, it is directed that team of State/UT should include the players of their State/UT only. No player is allowed to change the chest number which is mentioned in the Entry-Form without informing the Referee In-charge in writing.

The Coach, Manager of the team along with Secretary and President of the affiliated unit will be responsible for the compliance as per declaration on the Entry Form.

Boarding & Lodging:

The **Organizing Committee** will provide **free boarding and lodging** to the participating teams and officials, including local transportation, from **24th December 2025 to 29th December 2025**.

Uniform & Dress Code: All teams must wear colour-coordinated uniforms with chest numbers Front Side: 4" size, Back Side: 6" size, any team or player violating the dress code shall be subject to disciplinary action.

The Online Entry Submission Deadline is 22nd December 2025. Your cooperation in ensuring the timely submission of entries is essential to make the championship a grand success.

State Flag: All teams must carry their State/UT Flag for the March Past.
