SELECTION OF THE PROBABLE PLAYERS FOR SENDING INDIAN KABADDI TEAM (BOYS & GIRLS) TO THE UPCOMING 3RD ASIAN YOUTH GAMES 2025 SCHEDULED TO BE HELD IN BAHRAIN FROM 22ND TO 31ST OCTOBER 2025.

The camper list of the probable players for the National Coaching Camp for the further participation in the forthcoming 3rd Asian Youth Games 2025 is required to be submitted by Amateur Kabaddi Federation of India (AKFI) in a timely manner. 3rd Asian Youth Games (3AYG) 2025 scheduled to be held in Bahrain from 22nd to 31st October 2025.

In view of the above, the President AKFI constituted two Selection Committees for Boys and Girls respectively comprising the following esteemed members to select the probable players for the 1st U-18 National Kabaddi Coaching Camp:

Selection Committee Members (For Boys):

The 1st Under 18 National Kabaddi Championship 2025 (Boys and Girls) was held in Haridwar, Uttarakhand from 28th June 2025 to 1st July 2025. The Selection Committee constituted by the Federation supervised and finalized the selection process by assessing the performances of the participating players during the Championship. The Selection Committee members impartially and without any external influence, based on merit and experience selected a total of 44 best probable boys and 44 best probable girls athletes.

Further, it is important to notify here that there is an online accreditation process of the long list of the players by the Organising Committee and the requisites details are required to be submitted to IOA as per their time-to-time directives. The extended deadline for submission of Accreditation Applications for Athletes to IOA for further participation in the 3AYG 2025 was until 31st July 2025. The consistent efforts for the passports generation of the selected under-18 probable players were taken up by them which undertook its own procedural time. Consecutively, the list of campers (Boys and Girls) includes only the names whose passports and other requisites details were received by the NSF within the extended deadline. Clear directives were laid by IOA to adhere to the deadline and entries post the deadline were explicitly specified not to be processed. The list of the campers (Boys and Girls) includes the athletes (in total 60) whose entries are accepted by the Accreditation Long List (ACR List) by IOA.
