Subject: Mandatory Compliance with AKFI Rules & Prior Approval required for Outside Championships/Leagues/Tournaments participation.

All Certified Technical Officials of the AKFI are hereby directed to strictly adhere to the Rules, Regulations, and Code of Conduct prescribed by the AKFI.

It has come to the notice of the Federation that certain officials are aligning with or accepting assignments in external championships, leagues, tournaments, or similar sporting formats without obtaining prior approval from the AKFI.

In this regard, the following is reiterated for strict compliance:

No Certified AKFI Technical Official shall officiate, associate, endorse, or participate in any outside championship, league, tournament, or format not organized, recognized, or approved by the AKFI without obtaining prior written permission and No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the Federation.

Any request for such participation must be submitted in writing to the competent authority of the AKFI well in advance.

Approval shall be granted solely at the discretion of the AKFI after due review.

Failure to comply with the above directions shall be treated as a serious violation of AKFI Rules and Regulations. Any official found contravening these instructions shall face strict disciplinary action, which may include suspension, cancellation of certification, blacklisting, or any other action deemed appropriate by the Federation.

This circular shall come into effect immediately and must be treated as most urgent and mandatory.
